FETC 200 Club Rules

- 1, The purpose of the 200 Club is to raise funds for FETC Subsidised Therapy Fund. This Fund makes counselling available to those people who may not be able to afford the cost of sessions.
2. The name of the draw is the 200 Club, regardless of the number of shares.
3. The 200 Club will be administered by a promoter appointed by the FETC Council.
4. 50% of the total annual subscriptions will be paid out in the form of prizes.
5. Prizes will be set out pro rata, based on the actual numbers of participants at the time of each draw. The draws shall run from November 2012 onwards for a period of 12 months or until renewal of the next 12 months subscription by the share holder.
6. Membership of the 200 Club is open to anyone aged 16 and over.
7. A purchaser of a share becomes a member of the 200 Club.
8. Participants are entitled to hold any number of shares.
9. The number of shares in the 200 Club shall be unlimited and each share will be allocated a unique number of which members will be informed.
10. All shares purchased in a calendar month will be included in the next month's draw, which will take place at the beginning of each calendar month.
11. The subscriptions for each share is £12.00.
12. All participants must pay annually **in advance** by cheque, Standing Order or electronic transfer.
13. In the presence of two people, one of whom must be a FETC council member, the winning numbers will be selected from all the numbers qualifying.
14. The results will be posted on the News page of FETC website and in the FETC newsletter.
15. The winners' cheques will be sent out to the last known address held by the FETC 200 Club administrator. It is the responsibility of the members to advise the 200 Club administrator of any change of address. Any prize money not cashed within a year will be deemed to be a cash donation to the Foundation for Emotional Therapeutic Counselling.
16. The FETC will only pay a prize to the purchaser of the share or the name of the gift holder on the membership form.
